Each application shall be accompanied with a set of plans showing the property keeping domestic animals, lot lines, location of the stable, barn or other shelter, location of any watercourses or wetlands, location of all drains and sanitary systems, and location of all adjacent dwellings.

The owners of any premises on which any domestic animal requiring a permit shall be responsible for the sanitary, humane and safe-keeping of such animals. Shelters shall be kept clean and free of dirt, decaying food, manure and stagnant water. Buildings and pens shall be adequately heated and shall be whitewashed or disinfected if ordered by the Dedham Board of Health with regular spraying and baiting to prevent insects and rodents from becoming a health hazard.

By signing you are confirming that you have read and understand the Town of Dedham regulations pertaining to Keeping Domestic Animals. You also agree to abide by these regulations set forth by the Town of Dedham Board of Health. If your establishment is in non-compliance of these regulations you may have your permit suspended indefinitely.
