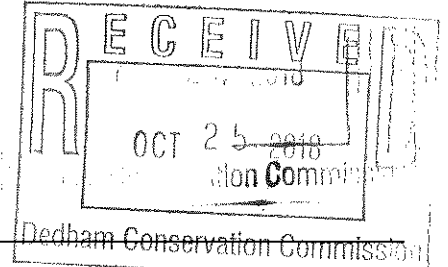

- Any commercial, industrial, institutional or municipal alteration, disturbance, development or redevelopment of at least 500 square feet in an Aquifer Protection Overlay District.
