Location & Date:

Hazardous Waste Day is held at the Department of Public Works, which is located at 55 River Street. It will be held on **Saturday, October 3, 2020 from 9 a.m. – 12 p.m.**

COVID-19 Guidelines:

All residents are required to wear face coverings and must follow Social Distancing guidelines. Waste will only be accepted from a vehicle. Residents must stay in the vehicle at all times, absolutely **no walk-ins allowed**. Staff will remove items from trunk or back seat. Please have proof of residency (driver's license) accessible before entering the drive-thru line.

Cost: There is no cost for Hazardous Waste for residents just proof of residency.

Television and computer monitors will cost \$20.00 per unit for disposal, cash or check only. Checks should be made payable to the Town of Dedham.
