



Weekly Project Updates and 7-Day Look-Ahead

Here is a look-ahead at the construction work planned for the Public Safety Building, from February 1, 2021 to February 5, 2021:

Project Overview:

Construction of a combined public safety building commenced in December 2020 on the site of the former Town Hall at 26 Bryant Street. The new building will house the staff and equipment of Fire, Police, and Dispatch departments. The new combined Public Safety Building will replace two older Town buildings: Police Station at 600 High Street (built in 1962) and the Fire Station at 436 Washington Street (built in 1930).

What to expect February 1, 2021 through February 5, 2021:

- The project site remains closed to the public.
- Construction crews will continue excavation and the installation of support for the excavated areas. To perform this work, crew members will be using large excavation machinery, equipped with back-up alarms that may be heard around the project site.
- Excavated soils will continue to be hauled off-site. Large trucks may be entering and exiting the project site along Bryant Street and Union Street to remove the excavated soils from the site.
- Eversource crews will be working along Bryant Street to install temporary power to the site.
- No additional traffic impacts or pedestrian impacts are anticipated during this week.

Crews will be working on site Monday through Friday, from 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM
