



Weekly Project Updates and 7-Day Look-Ahead

Here is a look-ahead at the construction work planned for the Public Safety Building, from February 22, 2021 to February 26, 2021

## **Project Overview:**

Construction of a combined public safety building commenced in December 2020 on the site of the former Town Hall at 26 Bryant Street. The new building will house the staff and equipment of Fire, Police, and Dispatch departments. The new combined Public Safety Building will replace two older Town buildings: Police Station at 600 High Street (built in 1962) and the Fire Station at 436 Washington Street (built in 1930). The new building is scheduled to open in the fall of 2022.

## What to expect February 22, 2021 (Monday) through February 26, 2021 (Friday):

- The project site remains closed to the public.
- On Monday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>, crews will begin to mobilize equipment in preparation for upcoming ground improvement and foundation work.
- Ground improvement work includes vibratory compaction so some vibrations might be felt outside of the project site. However, the project team anticipates than any vibrations felt outside the project site will be below industry recognized levels at which structures could incur damage. Crews will be continuously monitoring this work to mitigate any disturbances. This work is scheduled to begin mid-week and is scheduled to be completed by the end of March 2021.
- During the ground improvement work, crews will be using large machinery and trucks, equipped with backup alarms that may be heard around the project site. Trucks may be entering and exiting the site along Bryant Street, hauling material to the site.
- On Monday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>, crews will be removing approximately 7 10 truckloads of soil from the site between 7:00 AM and 3:00 PM. Trucks will be exiting the project site at the corner of Bryant Street and Washington Street. After exiting the project site, trucks will turn right onto Eastern Avenue and will turn right onto Route 1. A Dedham Police Department Officer will be on-site to assist with traffic flow.
- No additional traffic impacts or pedestrian impacts are anticipated during this week.

## **Construction Hours:**

Crews will be working on-site Monday through Friday, from 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM
