Meeting minutes:

July 2020 minutes were accepted by roll call vote.

I Am Dedham:

The HRC determined at a previous meeting to streamline the format of the I Am Dedham show and have a monthly topic or theme. Our next taping will be September 8th, conducted via Zoom. Margaret Adams: cannot do September 8th. Is interested in featuring the Anti-Racism Coalition. Margaret Matthews: has a possible guest from the Dedham Historical Society; has sent confirmation email but has not received a reply. Also interested in increasing the number of Dedham leaders interviewed.

Joe: suggests that we interview the police chief; also increase focus on "making things happen." Rob: has some youth who could potentially be guests.

Interrupting Racism training:

Mixed feedback from those HRC members who attended, particularly 2 aspects:

- Expanding invitees to include non-Dedham participants
- Combining the last 2 scheduled meetings into 1

Participants felt that this 'diluted' the experience.

REMAP (Racial Equity Municipal Action Plan) Program

Dedham Education Foundation (Mayanne)

Mayanne reports that the annual grant proposal cycle has started.

Interfaith group (Mike)

The faith organizations in Dedham have come together to galvanize over human rights. Mike reports that the first meeting went well. Next meeting August 31 at 1 p.m.

Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Coordinator hiring committee (Chris) Chris updated us on the hiring process. 6 interviews were held this week and finalists will be forwarded to the next step, which is site visits and community meetings.
