TOWN HALL AND TOWN OFFICES PREPARE TO REOPEN

In light of <u>Governor Baker's announcement on May 17</u>, the Town of Dedham will continue offering in-person services at Town Hall by appointment only, **from Monday, May 24 through Friday, May 28** during posted business hours. Summer hours at Town Hall will go into effect on Friday, May 28 and Town Hall will close at 1:00 p.m. on Fridays through September 3.

Operations at Town Hall as of Monday, May 24, 2021:

Town Hall will reopen to in-person service by appointment-only on Monday, May 24 and will adhere the following protocols:

- Appointments are required for members of the public to enter Town Hall
- All visitors to Town Hall must enter and exit through the rear entrance of the building
- Employees and visitors must wear masks/face coverings when within Town Hall and practice social distancing of at least 6 feet

Operations at Town Hall and Town Offices as of Tuesday, June 1, 2021:

Town offices will be closed on Monday, May 31 in observance of Memorial Day. Beginning on Tuesday, June 1, Town offices will reopen to the public and the Town of Dedham will follow the Massachusetts Governor's Order released on Monday, May 17 to rescind the mask mandate and lift other Covid-19 restrictions currently in place. Listed below are the updated Covid-19 protocols in place in Town offices and buildings, as of June 1:

- Appointments are no longer required to enter Town Hall to conduct business
- All Town buildings will be open to the public during normal business hours and both entrances to Town Hall will be open
- Masks are no longer required for fully vaccinated individuals
- Non-vaccinated individuals are advised to continue wearing face masks and to continue to practice social distancing within Town buildings of at least 6 feet
- Capacity in Town buildings will increase to 100% and there will be no limit on gathering sizes

Crews completed the underground sewer line installation at Union Place on Friday, May 22, 2021. On Monday, May 24, 2021, crews will finish paving Union Place and the roadway will be reopened to through traffic and parking lots on Tuesday, May 25, 2021.

Crews will continue the installation and forming of rebar for the west wall and will begin work to install the footings and piers for the interior walls of the building.
