2020 I/I Inspection Project

The Town of Dedham Engineering Department is pleased to announce that the 2020 I/I Inspection Project is now complete. This project involved the inspection of approximately 120,000 linear feet (22.7 miles) of sewer mains, 113 private sewer laterals and 542 sewer manholes.

The contractor for the project responsible for inspection of the sewer mains and laterals was National Water Main Cleaning Co. of Canton, MA and the consultant for the project responsible for the inspection of the sewer manholes was Weston & Sampson. Work on the project began in March and was completed in October at a total cost of approximately \$254,500.

The Engineering Department prepared all contract documents, bid and awarded the contract, and performed all resident inspection and contract administration in-house.

This project is part of the overall Inflow and Infiltration reduction project currently underway. The findings of this project will be incorporated into our current rehabilitation contract (also awarded to Rapid Flow, Inc.) to remove extraneous clean water that enters the sanitary sewer system.
