CONSTRUCTION & ROADWORK AROUND TOWN

- Bridge Street Paving (<u>MassDOT Project</u>)
 Curbing and Sidewalk work will continue this week. The contractor will begin near Bingham Avenue and continue in the direction of Moseley's On the Charles.

Eversource Gas:

- Lincoln Street: The gas main is installed. Eversource will be removing old valve boxes.
- Elmwood Ave: Work continues from Adams to Jefferson. This work will continue thru July. Crews will work on Adams Street after Elmwood is complete/
- Court Street/Washington Street/Wilson Ave: Work will continue on Washington St and crews will work in the direction of Richards Street.

Rustcraft Road

- Eversource Electric has installed the majority of the conduit. Crews will be onsite working on installing manholes and handholes
- Expect traffic delays in and around the area this week.

Sprague Street Sidewalk Construction:

Limits of work are from Cedar Street to Greenlodge Street, and from Cedar Street to Dresser Ave. This work is scheduled to be completed during the week of July 25, 2021.
