PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

What to expect July 5, 2021 (Monday) through July 9, 2021 (Friday):

- The project site remains closed to the public.
- Crews will be working onsite on Saturday, July 3, 2021, from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM to complete the excavation for foundations.
- Crews will continue concrete placement for foundations next week.
- Equipment and materials will continue to be offloaded and removed from the site.
- Beginning Tuesday, July 6, the steel erector will mobilize onsite and the crane that will be used for steel installation will be moved into place.
- Delivery of materials for steel erection will begin next week. Expect periodic entrance and exit of large trucks at the project site entrance, located at the intersection of Washington Street and Bryant Street.
- No additional traffic impacts or pedestrian impacts are anticipated during this week.
- Crews will be onsite, Tuesday through Friday, from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM
