Michelle Kayserman called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

- 1. Public Comment No public comment offered
- 2. Minutes from the 2/23/2021 meeting were approved unanimously
- 3. Recap of Massachusetts Open Spaces Virtual Conference virtual sessions
  - a. Stephanie offered one addition for the OSRC Plan and for future committees to consider- Outreach to neighborhoods classified as Environmental Justice (EJ) populations based on English language isolation should be attempted in primary language(s) of those households
    - Specific areas: Neighborhood from Endicott train station/Oakdale neighborhood toward Dedham Corporate station and Neighborhood running between abandoned rail line and Milton/Bussey Streets (OSRP section 3C.6, Map 2 – page 23).
  - b. Bob asked about requesting money from the Town in order to better access grants available. Elissa suggested that the OSRC could request and have the Finance Committee

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- discuss the option. Fall Town Meeting might be the best time to make the monetary request from the Town.

      - Clarification <u>Dedham Trails website content</u> being switched over to the Town website <u>needs to happen first</u>, then we add more functionality and content
