Articles 9 and 14 - We approve Articles 9 and 14 from the May 17, 2021 Dedham Annual Town Meeting.<sup>1</sup>

Note: Pursuant to G.L. c. 40, § 32, neither general nor zoning by-laws take effect unless the Town has first satisfied the posting/publishing requirements of that statute. Once this statutory duty is fulfilled, (1) general by-laws and amendments take effect on the date these posting and publishing requirements are satisfied unless a later effective date is prescribed in the by-law, and (2) zoning by-laws and amendments are deemed to have taken effect from the date they were approved by the Town Meeting, unless a later effective date is prescribed in the by-law.

THE FOLLOWING BYLAWS HAVE BEEN APPROVED BY THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL ARTICLE 14 (Zoning), 9 (General).

At a legal meeting of qualified voters of the Town of Dedham, held on May 17, 2021 the following business was transacted under Articles 9 and 14

#### ARTICLE 9: DEPARTMENTAL REVOLVING FUNDS

To see if the Town will vote, pursuant to G.L.c.44, §53E½, to amend Section 39-40(b) of the General Bylaws, Revolving Funds, to alter any of the expenditure limits set forth therein, or take any other action relative thereto.

#### ARTICLE 14: ZONING AMENDMENT – SECTION 4.5.1

To see if the Town will vote to amend Section 4.5.1 of the Dedham Zoning By-Lawby adding at the end thereof the following new subsection:

d. A lot which otherwise satisfies the requirements and conditions of this Section shall retain its status as separate building lot notwithstanding saidlot is occupied by a garage, shed, or similar accessory structure,

or take any other action relative thereto.

Any person who for any reason desires to contest or challenge the validity of the foregoing Zoning By-Law amendments must file any claims of invalidity within ninety days of the second publication by filing a written claim with the Town Clerk.
