Residents of Dedham (proof of residency required) are encouraged to bring the following items if found at home for safe and proper disposal, at no cost:

- Oil Paint
- Pool Chemicals
- Motor Vehicle Oil
- Pesticides
- Antifreeze
- Fluorescent Light Bulbs
- Gasoline
- Household Chemicals
- Mercury Thermometers
- 1 Pound Propane Cylinders
- Rechargeable Batteries



Residents are also permitted to bring televisions and computer monitors for disposal. Each unit for disposal will cost \$20, paid by cash or check only. (If paying by check, please make check payable to the "Town of Dedham".



The Board reports that as of Thursday, September 23rd, there have been 2,682 confirmed COVID-19 cases in Town. This is an increase of 25 cases from last week's update. Currently, there are 34 active confirmed cases.

FINANCE & WARRANT COMMITTEE MEETINGS BEGIN FOR FALL TOWN MEETING

Annual Fall Town Meeting is scheduled for Monday, November 15th and the **Finance & Warrant Committee** (FWC) meetings begin on Wednesday, September 29th.

The FWC oversees and makes recommendations on all municipal financial matters, including the annual budget, financial management, policy, and planning. The FWC meetings are open to the public and each meeting serves as an important step toward Town Meeting.

During each FWC meeting, one or more warrant articles may be discussed and reviewed by asking questions to staff and community representatives who have prepared the articles. It is through this process that FWC develops their recommendations to Town Meeting members to vote at Town Meeting. Members of the public are welcome to attend and encouraged to tune it to learn more about the process leading up to and including Town Meeting.

ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT SHARES SEPTIC SYSTEM TIPS AND BEST PRACTICES FOR HOMEOWNERS

Homes and other properties not connected to the Town's Sanitary Sewer System have their own septic tank or cesspool system. Proper operation and maintenance of these systems is important not only to prevent sewage backups into the house, but to also prevent groundwater contamination.

Tips to Maintain Your System:

- Schedule regular inspections and pumping (based on of system, household, total wastewater generated, and volume of solids in wastewater)
- Efficient use of water
- Proper waste disposal
- Mind your drainfield

Available for free on the Town website is a Homeowner's Guide to Septic Systems that includes tips and information to help you maintain your septic/cesspool systems and prevent potential issues.

PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING PROJECT UPDATES

What to expect September 27, 2021 (Monday) through October 1, 2021 (Friday):

- The project site remains closed to the public.
- The dewatering system remains in place and operational.
- Crews will begin to focus on the remaining section of the steel decking and detail work on the roof.
- On Monday, September 20, 2021, crews placed the first floor concrete slab and placed the concrete slab for the second floor Police area on Wednesday, September 22, 2021.
- Concrete slab placement this week will include:
 - Monday, September 27, 2021: Remainder of the first floor concrete

 - Tuesday, September 28, 2021: Remainder of second floor Fire area
 Wednesday, September 29, 2021: Roof level for both Police and Fire areas
- *NOTE: Please Expect trucks to be entering and exiting the site during this time to deliver concrete.

• Plumbing and electrical contractors will be onsite to install underground utilities in the basement and subsurface garage.

• Expect periodic entrance and exit of large trucks at the project site entrance, located at the intersection of Washington Street and Bryant Street. **Please expect minor traffic delays at this intersection**.

• No additional traffic impacts or pedestrian impacts are anticipated during this week.


