Weekly Project Updates and
7-Day Look-Ahead

**Here is a look-ahead at the construction work planned for the Public Safety Building,
from October 18, 2021 to October 22, 2021**

Project Overview:

Construction of a combined public safety building commenced in December 2020 on the site of the former Town Hall at 26 Bryant Street. The new building will house the staff and equipment of Fire, Police, and Dispatch departments. The new combined Public Safety Building will replace two older Town buildings: Police Station at 600 High Street (built in 1962) and the Fire Station at 436 Washington Street (built in 1930). The new building is scheduled to open in the Fall of 2022.

What to expect October 18, 2021 (Monday) through October 22, 2021 (Friday):

- The project site remains closed to the public.
- Crews will be onsite **Saturday, October 16, 2021** to continue backfilling operations throughout the site.
- As of **Friday, October 15, 2021**, contractors completed the following work:
 - Installation of underground plumbing and electrical utilities
 - Inspection of underground plumbing and electrical utilities
 - First floor topping slab concrete placement
- On **Thursday, October 14, 2021**, the contractor began the elevator piston and casing drilling. This work is expected to continue for approximately one week.
- Along the north elevation, the masonry contractors will begin to install the concrete masonry unit (CMU) wall. This work will include deliveries of materials and trucks will be entering and exiting the site at the intersection of Washington Street and Bryant Street.
- Plumber will be onsite this week to install sub-slab depressurization (SSD) piping in the basement/garage area of the building.
- Crews will continue to install and backfill the perimeter foundation drain along the north elevation this week
- Contractors onsite are planning to install drainage manholes and a water quality structure on Bryant Street that is expected to begin on **Friday, October 22, 2021**. This work may cause traffic delays within the area. More information and updates will be provided prior to the start of work to help facilitate travel in and around this area.
- Expect periodic entrance and exit of large trucks at the project site entrance, located at the intersection of Washington Street and Bryant Street. **Please expect minor traffic delays at this intersection.**
- No additional traffic impacts or pedestrian impacts are anticipated during this week.

Public Viewing Area:

If you want to stop by to check out the progress, stand by the picnic table outside the north entrance to Town Hall. This spot provides a great view into the project site and is outside of the project boundaries. Worth a visit!

 - Monday through Friday: 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM
