

# PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING PROJECT

Weekly Project Updates and 7-Day Look-Ahead

## Here is a look-ahead at the construction work planned for the Public Safety Building, from October 25, 2021 to October 29, 2021

### **Project Overview:**

Construction of a combined public safety building commenced in December 2020 on the site of the former Town Hall at 26 Bryant Street. The new building will house the staff and equipment of Fire, Police, and Dispatch departments. The new combined Public Safety Building will replace two older Town buildings: Police Station at 600 High Street (built in 1962) and the Fire Station at 436 Washington Street (built in 1930). The new building is scheduled to open in the Fall of 2022.

#### What to expect October 25, 2021 (Monday) through October 29, 2021 (Friday):

- The project site remains closed to the public.
- Crews will be onsite **Saturday**, **October 23**, **2021** to continue backfilling operations throughout the site.
- As of Friday, October 22, 2021, contractors are nearing completion of roof area steel relief angle installation.
- Last week, the masonry contractors began the installation of the concrete masonry unit (CMU) wall along the
  north, east, and south sides of the site. This work will continue into this week and will include deliveries of
  materials and trucks will be entering and exiting the site at the intersection of Washington Street and Bryant
  Street.
- The plumbing contractors will be onsite this week to continue the installation of sub-slab depressurization (SSD) piping in the basement/garage area of the building. The contractors will also begin to install rain leader piping that will help direct stormwater away from the building.
- Crews will continue to install and backfill the perimeter foundation drain along the west elevation.
- Crews onsite will continue to backfill up to grade and remove jersey barriers, accordingly.
- Expect periodic entrance and exit of large trucks at the project site entrance, located at the intersection of Washington Street and Bryant Street. **Please expect minor traffic delays at this intersection.**
- No additional traffic impacts or pedestrian impacts are anticipated during this week.

#### **Public Viewing Area:**

If you want to stop by to check out the progress, stand by the picnic table outside the north entrance to Town Hall. This spot provides a great view into the project site and is outside of the project boundaries. Worth a visit!
