
COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic for Children 5-11 Years Old

On Tuesday, November 2nd, the CDC Director approved the FDA's recommendation to vaccinate children 5-11 years with the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine. The recommended vaccine is 1/3 of the dose administered to youths 12 years and older and adults. Children 5-11 years old are now eligible to receive the Pfizer vaccine.

There will be a COVID-19 clinic for Dedham residents 5-11 years old on **Saturday**, **November 20th** at the **Dedham Middle School (70 Whiting Ave)** from 9:00 AM – 12:30 PM. **Online registration in advance is required**.

GREENLODGE STREET CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT UPDATES

The Dedham Engineering Department and consultants, Dewberry, presented the draft plans for improvements to the Greenlodge Street Corridor during a virtual, public information meeting on **Wednesday**, **November 10**, **2021**. Anyone interested was invited to attend to meet the project team and to ask questions about the plans for pedestrian and roadway improvements along this corridor. <u>Greenlodge Street Corridor Improvements - Presentation & Plans</u>

During the presentation, the project team shared the following updates:

- A resident of the Greenlodge neighborhood submitted a Traffic Calming Request Form to the Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) in December 2020
 - Greenlodge was not eligible for evaluation as a minor collector roadway; the TAC received a waiver from the Select Board to review given its proximity to a local elementary school
- Study revealed speeding issue during and after posted school hours
- Following recommendations and considerations for improvements to reduce speed and increase safety for drivers and pedestrians presented to Select Board (who voted unanimously to support):
 - Narrow roadways
 - Reconfigure intersections to reduce crosswalk exposure
 - Install new sidewalks on easterly side of Greenlodge, from Sprague Street to south entrance of Colwell Drive
- Approved \$84,000 at Town Meeting to hire consultants, Dewberry, to prepare the project designs
- Total project length is approximately 3900 feet
- Second sidewalk provides safer passage for pedestrians and will include design elements to enhance bicyclist safety
- standardize roadway widths to narrow (in places) and reduce speed
- Narrowed the intersections of Fox Meadow Lane and Colwell Drive (N) with Greenlodge Street to mitigate speeds and shorten crosswalk lengths
- Posted 20 MPH speed limit sign at curve near Rosen Road

PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING UPDATES

What to expect November 15, 2021 (Monday) through November 19, 2021 (Friday):

- The project site remains closed to the public. •
- The dewatering system remains in place and operational.
- Eversource is scheduled to begin utility pole installation on Monday, November 15, 2021.
- Crews completed half of the slab-on-grade installation and the wet curing process is underway.
- During this week, crews will continue the following work onsite:
 - Installation of Mirafi (geotextile fabric used to maintain soil separation), stone, vapor barrier, and rebar in the southern half of the garage
 - Installation of underground electric and overhead automatic transfer switch (ATS) conduits in the garage
 - Installation of drainage manholes and water quality 0 structure on Bryant Street
 - Installation of concrete masonry unit (CMU) wall along the 0 north, east, and south of the site
 - Installation of CMU wall along the interior cell blocks and о apparatus bays
 - Installation of second floor duct mains (currently 90% ο complete)
 - Installation of the oil/gas separator 0
 - o Continued installation of the rain leader piping (designed to direct stormwater away from the building)

The exterior cold formed metal framing and Densglass installation is underway and will continue this week.

- Densglass is sheathing made of fiberglass mat gypsum, used о for mold and moisture resistance
- Expect periodic entrance and exit of large trucks at the project site entrance, located at the intersection of Washington Street and Bryant Street. Please expect minor traffic delays at this intersection.
- No additional traffic impacts or pedestrian impacts are anticipated during this week.
