



Weekly Project Updates and 7-Day Look-Ahead

### Here is a look-ahead at the construction work planned for the Public Safety Building, from January 31, 2022 to February 4, 2022

## **Project Overview:**

Construction of a combined public safety building commenced in December 2020 on the site of the former Town Hall at 26 Bryant Street. The new building will house the staff and equipment of Fire, Police, and Dispatch departments. The new combined Public Safety Building will replace two older Town buildings: Police Station at 600 High Street (built in 1962) and the Fire Station at 436 Washington Street (built in 1930). The new building is scheduled to open in the Fall of 2022.

## What to expect January 31, 2022 (Monday) through February 4, 2022 (Friday):

- The project site remains closed to the public.
- Crews will continue mechanical, electrical, fire protection, and plumbing installations this week.
- Installation of the stormwater infiltration system will continue this week.
- Installation of Stair #1 is underway.
- Repairs to the elevator shaft are nearing completion and the anticipated delivery date of the elevator is March 1, 2022.
- The 4-inch construction masonry unit walls are being installed in the garage and the work will continue this week.
- Eversource crews will be onsite to relocate the existing overhead utility wires from the existing poles to the newly installed poles.
- Roofers will continue to install the roof framing and parapet walls at the edges of the roof. Roof installation has begun on the high Police roof and will continue this week.
- Crews will continue the installation of air and vapor barriers along the eastern side of the building this week.
- Expect periodic entrance and exit of large trucks at the project site entrance, located at the intersection of Washington Street and Bryant Street. **Please expect minor traffic delays at this intersection.**
- No additional traffic impacts or pedestrian impacts are anticipated during this week.

# Upcoming Snowstorm (1/28/22 to 1/30/22):

Crews will not be working onsite on Saturday, January 29, 2022 due to the impending snowstorm. On Sunday, January 30, 2022, contractors will be onsite to remove snow from the Tower roof and high police roof. Another crew will also be onsite on Sunday to help remove snow from the jobsite in anticipation of work to resume as scheduled on Monday, January 31, 2022.

## **Public Viewing Area:**

If you want to stop by to check out the progress, stand by the picnic table outside the north entrance to Town Hall. This spot provides a great view into the project site and is outside of the project boundaries. Worth a visit!
