



Weekly Project Updates and 7-Day Look-Ahead

# Here is a look-ahead at the construction work planned for the Public Safety Building, from February 7, 2022 to February 11, 2022

## **Project Overview:**

Construction of a combined public safety building commenced in December 2020 on the site of the former Town Hall at 26 Bryant Street. The new building will house the staff and equipment of Fire, Police, and Dispatch departments. The new combined Public Safety Building will replace two older Town buildings: Police Station at 600 High Street (built in 1962) and the Fire Station at 436 Washington Street (built in 1930). The new building is scheduled to open in the Fall of 2022.

# What to expect February 7, 2022 (Monday) through February 11, 2022 (Friday):

- The project site remains closed to the public.
- Installation of interior and exterior cold formed metal framing and Densglass sheathing continues this week on all floors. Crews are nearing completion of exterior installations.
- Crews will be installing the air/vapor barrier along the south side of the building this week.
- Within the garage, crews will all continue to install 4" CMU walls.
- Roofers will continue to install the roof framing and parapet walls.
- Eversource Line Transfer Crews will continue working onsite to relocate the existing overhead utility lines from the existing poles to the newly installed poles along Bryant Street.
- Expect periodic entrance and exit of large trucks at the project site entrance, located at the intersection of Washington Street and Bryant Street. **Please expect minor traffic delays at this intersection.**
- No additional traffic impacts or pedestrian impacts are anticipated during this week.

## **Public Viewing Area:**

If you want to stop by to check out the progress, stand by the picnic table outside the north entrance to Town Hall. This spot provides a great view into the project site and is outside of the project boundaries. Worth a visit!
