SELECT BOARD TO HOST VIRTUAL COMMUNITY SESSION TO COLLECT COMMENTS ABOUT MBTA EAST STREET BRIDGE RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

To help the Town gather public comments for submittal to the MBTA, the Select Board will be hosting a virtual community session for the East Street Bridge Reconstruction Project on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>March 30</u>, <u>2022 at 6:30 p.m. via Zoom</u>.

The Select Board, joined by Town staff, welcome all comments regarding the MBTA project to include in the Town's packet to the MBTA Project Team. The Select Board and Town Staff will begin the session with a brief statement before opening it up to receive comments from those in attendance. Each participant will receive three minutes to share their comments, and each will be recorded for inclusion in the report shared with the MBTA Project Team.

The MBTA Project Team hosted a <u>virtual public information session on December 9</u>, <u>2021</u> to introduce themselves to the community and to share their plans at the 30% design phase. Prior to that meeting, the MBTA set up a project-specific website, <u>www.mbta.com/EastStBridge</u>, to house their notifications, project status updates, background information, recording of the meeting, and presentation slides. In early March, the project team shared a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) document with the Town that summarized the comments received during the December meeting that are available on the project website and were <u>shared by the Town on March 4</u>, <u>2022</u>.

The project is still in the design phase and the MBTA Project Team has indicated to the Town they will host another public meeting before the final designs are complete. The meeting date/time will be shared when the information is available.

The Board of Health will transition their weekly COVID-19 update to a bi-weekly general Board of Health update. These updates will continue to include any relevant COVID-19 information but will also include information about health topics and Board of Health permitting. Upcoming Board of Health Permitting

With Spring here, the following Board of Health permits will be expiring and require renewal:

- Domestic Animals (chickens) expire June 30th
- Pools and Whirlpools/Spas expire June 30th
- Saunas and Steam Rooms expire June 30th
- Tanning Facilities expire June 30th
- Waste Hauler and Septic Installer expire June 30th

Other businesses such as Farmers Market food vendors and recreational camp for children operators must also apply for permits before beginning seasonal operations. Household Hazardous Waste Day

The next Household Hazardous Waste Day will be on **Saturday, April 30, 2022**, from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM at the Department of Public Works (55 River Street).

The following items will be accepted: oil paint, pool chemicals, motor vehicle chemicals, pesticides, antifreeze, fluorescent light bulbs, gasoline, household chemicals, mercury thermometers, 1 pound propane cylinders, and rechargeable batteries.

The following items will **NOT** be accepted: latex paint, fire extinguishers, motor vehicle batteries, appliances, tires, and propane tanks.

TOWN RECYCLING DAY IS SATURDAY, APRIL 2, 2022



On **Saturday**, **April 2** at the Dedham Middle School, the Town of Dedham Department of Public Works (DPW), Sustainability Advisory Committee, and the Neponset Valley Sunrise Rotary Club will be co-hosting a town-wide recycling event, open to all Dedham residents, **from 8:00 a.m. to Noon**.

Items that will be accepted at this event include:

- Scrap Metal
- Paper Shredding
- Electronics*
- Styrofoam**

*Electronics will be accepted for a fee. A complete list of pricing can be found on the Town website at <u>www.dedham-ma.gov</u>.

**Only rigid foam will be accepted. Packing peanuts, meat trays, and soft foam will not be accepted.

Textiles, linens, clothing, footwear, and stuffed animals can be dropped off using the large, white collection bins located in the Middle School parking lot. Additional collection boxes are located in the parking lots at the Avery Elementary School, Greenlodge Elementary School, Riverdale Elementary School, and the Early Childhood Education Center. The collection bins are offered by Bay State Textiles and are emptied on a regular basis and provide an opportunity for residents to recycle accepted items at no cost.

PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING UPDATES

What to expect March 28, 2022 (Monday) through April 1, 2022 (Friday):

The project site remains closed to the public.

- Crews will continue the mechanical, electrical, fire protection system, and plumbing installations this week.
- Piping along the second floor of the Fire Department will continue to be insulated this week.
- Installation of the exterior stone (Shouldice) will continue along the North, South and West sides of the building.
- Anticipated delivery date of the elevator is the end of March. All elevator repairs are complete and is awaiting installation of elevator.
- The interior cold formed metal framing and Densglass will continue to be installed on all floors of the building and along all exteriors next week.
- The roofing subcontractor is nearing completion of the work and punch list items are ongoing.
- Air Vapor Barrier nearing completion, Punch List repairs ongoing.
- As of Friday, March 14, 2022, all repairs to the stair #1 slab have been completed.
- A date has not yet been set for placement of the generator pad and transformer pad. Will provide updates when available for this week.
- Expect periodic entrance and exit of large trucks at the project site entrance, located at the intersection of Washington Street and Bryant Street. Please expect minor traffic delays at this intersection.
- No additional traffic impacts or pedestrian impacts are anticipated during this week.


