



Weekly Project Updates and 7-Day Look-Ahead

# Here is a look-ahead at the construction work planned for the Public Safety Building, from July 25, 2022 to July 29, 2022

### **Project Overview:**

Construction of a combined public safety building commenced in December 2020 on the site of the former Town Hall at 26 Bryant Street. The new building will house the staff and equipment of Fire, Police, and Dispatch departments. The new combined Public Safety Building will replace two older Town buildings: Police Station at 600 High Street (built in 1962) and the Fire Station at 436 Washington Street (built in 1930). The new building is scheduled to open in the Fall of 2022.

# What to expect July 25, 2022 (Monday) through July 29, 2022 (Friday):

- The project site remains closed to the public.
- Contractors are scheduled work onsite on **Saturday**, **July 23**, **2022**, **between 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM**. No impacts to vehicular or pedestrian travel are anticipated as a result of this work.
- Roadwork will continue on Bryant Street to install conduit for new traffic lights this week. Vehicular
  travel will be reduced to one lane during work hours, 7AM to 3:30PM, and Police and signage will be
  onsite to help assist with traffic management. Please use extreme caution when travelling in this area,
  watch for pedestrians, and expect minor delays.
- Elevator and elevator machine room installation will continue this week.
- HVAC contractors will continue the installation of valves and associated piping for the induction units located on the second floor of the Police Station. In addition, they will be installing condensate pumps on the second floor of the Fire Station.
- Sheet metal will be installed for the duct work above the kitchen exhaust hood.
- Plumbers will continue the installation of piping equipment in the Mechanical Room and to the gas/oil separator.
- Electrical contractors will continue pulling data wire for the second floor of both Police and Fire Stations, and will install lighting on these floors. Additional rough in lights will be installed throughout the building.
- Painting crews will work on priming and painting the walls on the first floor and in the cell blocks within the Police Station.
- Acoustical ceiling tile grids will be installed on the second floor of the Fire Station this week.
- The curtainwall subcontractor will be installing the curtain wall grid this week along the north side of the building.
- Metal parapet wall caps will be installed along the east and south sides of the roof.
- Contractors will continue to grade the underground garage entrance ramp, and install the ramp curbing this week.
- Millwork materials have been delivered and installation will continue on the second floor of the Police and Fire stations.

- Expect periodic entrance and exit of large trucks at the project site entrance, located at the intersection of Washington Street and Bryant Street. **Please expect minor traffic delays at this intersection.**
- No additional traffic impacts or pedestrian impacts are anticipated during this week.

# **Public Viewing Area:**

If you want to stop by to check out the progress, stand by the picnic table outside the north entrance to Town Hall. This spot provides a great view into the project site and is outside of the project boundaries. Worth a visit!
