



Weekly Project Updates and 7-Day Look-Ahead

# Here is a look-ahead at the construction work planned for the Public Safety Building, from August 22, 2022 to August 26, 2022

#### **Project Overview:**

Construction of a combined public safety building commenced in December 2020 on the site of the former Town Hall at 26 Bryant Street. The new building will house the staff and equipment of Fire, Police, and Dispatch departments. The new combined Public Safety Building will replace two older Town buildings: Police Station at 600 High Street (built in 1962) and the Fire Station at 436 Washington Street (built in 1930). The new building is scheduled to open in the Fall of 2022.

### What to expect August 22, 2022 (Monday) through August 26, 2022 (Friday):

- The project site remains closed to the public.
- Contractors will be working onsite on **Saturday**, **August 20**, **2022**, between 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM. All work will occur with the site boundaries and no vehicular or pedestrian impacts are anticipated.
- Installation of epoxy flooring will continue this week within one of the gear locker rooms and within the bathrooms located on the first floor of the Police Station.
- HVAC contractors will continue to install valves and associated piping for the inductions units located on the second floor of the Police Station. Additionally, contractors will be insulating the induction unit piping on the second floor of the Fire Station.
- Plumbers will rough install plumbing at the Apparatus Bay and will insulate piping within the Apparatus Bay.
- Permanent power was supplied to the building on July 28, 2022 in anticipation of the generator. Delivery of the generator is pending, and an updated delivery date will be provided when available.
- Contractors will be excavating and installing drainage piping along the north side of the building exterior.
- Electrical contractors will continue to pull data wires to the second floor of both Police and Fire Stations, install fire alarm devices on the second floor of the Police and Fire Stations, install more lights on the second floor of the Fire Station, and will begin to remove temporary lighting and power.
- Painters will continue working on the ceiling and walls of the Apparatus Bay.
- Ceramic tiles will be installed on the second floor of the Police and Fire Stations.
- Expect periodic entrance and exit of large trucks at the project site entrance, located at the intersection of Washington Street and Bryant Street. **Please expect minor traffic delays at this intersection.**
- No additional traffic impacts or pedestrian impacts are anticipated during this week.

## **Public Viewing Area:**

If you want to stop by to check out the progress, stand by the picnic table outside the north entrance to Town Hall. This spot provides a great view into the project site and is outside of the project boundaries. Worth a visit!




