<u>Dedham Public School Permits</u> - Motion made by Commissioner Dello; 2nd by Commissioner O'Connell. Roll Call – Commissioners Farnham, Dello, O'Connell, and Chairwoman Moran all voted yes.

<u>Ursline Academy Permits</u> - Motion made by Commissioner Dello; 2nd by Commissioner Farnham. Roll Call – Commissioners Farnham, Dello, O'Connell, and Chairwoman Moran all voted yes.

<u>Dedham Youth Baseball</u> – Will not be getting Churchill on Fridays as that will be Dedham Girls Softball. The noted time on permit was copied from last year as 3-8 pm. Actual time is 5-8 pm. No snow fence being put up at Collins – and Kevin Doyle / Heath Purdy aware of this and fine. Little kids to be assigned to Collins so that that game can go o and soccer can play at same time. Motion made by Commissioner Dello; 2nd by Commissioner O'Connell. Roll Call – Commissioners Farnham, Dello, O'Connell all voted yes –Chairwoman Moran abstained from the vote as she helps at the concession stand for baseball.

Discussion was had about what we do if Jon does not make the meeting in time – as both Commissioners O'Connell and Farnham will both abstain from votes for Gonzalez dealing with soccer and lacrosse.
