If you are hurt on the job with a non-life threatening injury:

- Call the Occupational Health Center at Beth Israel Deaconess Hospital *Needham* (781) 453-8440 when an injury occurs or is reported, between the hours of 8 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. M/T/W/F. 8 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Thursday.
- Tell them you work for The Town of Dedham and have sustained a work-related injury and need to be evaluated.
- A provider will triage the injury on the phone and determine the best approach for care; OHS walk-in, OHS appointment, Emergency Room Visit.
- You will be treated and an injury status report will be faxed to the Workers Compensation Coordinator.

If you need medical care after hours due to a work injury:
