



Weekly Project Updates and 7-Day Look-Ahead

Here is a look-ahead at the construction work planned for the Public Safety Building, from June 5, 2023 through June 9, 2023

Project Status and Overview:

As of May 2, 2023, the Police Department, Fire Department, and Dispatch Team are operating out of the new Public Safety Building. The former Police Station, located at 600 High Street, will become the future Town Green, and the former Fire Station is currently undergoing abatement in advance of demolition. The building will be razed in Phase 3 of the Public Safety Building Project and will be replaced with parking spaces and small landscaped areas. The new combined Public Safety Building will replace two older Town buildings: Police Station at 600 High Street (built in 1962) and the Fire Station at 436 Washington Street (built in 1952). The new building is scheduled to reach final completion later this year and remains on budget.

What to expect June 5, 2023 (Monday) through June 9, 2023 (Friday):

- The new Public Safety Building is open to the public at 26 Bryant Street.
- As of Friday, June 2, 2023, demolition of the former Fire Station Building is complete and crews have demobilized the demolition equipment from the project site.
- Beginning on Monday, June 5, crews will bring new equipment to the project site to help with backfilling and compacting the excavated areas. Backfilling and compaction is expected to begin on **Tuesday**, **June 6**.
 - Vibratory monitoring devices will be used to monitor vibrations caused by this phase of work to ensure levels do not exceed regulatory standards.
 - Backfilling and compaction is anticipated to be completed on June 16.
- Landscaping crews will continue planting around the new Public Safety Building and along the perimeter of the rear parking lot at Town Hall. Parking spaces may be blocked off for large equipment and storage. Please take extreme caution when driving through these parking areas.
- Upon completion of this phase of the Public Safety Building Project, the site will be converted to additional parking spaces and landscaping that will connect the Town Hall and new Public Safety Building, creating a Municipal Campus.
- Please expect periodic entrance and exit of large trucks at the project site entrance and please expect minor traffic delays at this intersection.
- No additional traffic impacts or pedestrian impacts are anticipated during this week.
