

The Dedham Flag Day Committee is again requesting permission to conduct their 49th ANNUAL DEDHAM FLAG DAY PARADE on Tuesday, June 14th starting at 6pm on East Street.

The Route is as follows: Starting on East Street, moving down to High Street, Left on to High Street (wrong side of the road) up to Dedham Square, Right on to Washington Street to Harris Avenue, Right on Harris Avenue to High Street, Follow High Street all the way to East Dedham Square, Right on to Milton Street to Walnut Street, Right on to Walnut Street to Oakdale Avenue, Left on Oakdale Avenue to Oakdale Square, Up Sanderson Avenue to Mt. Vernon Street, Right on Mt. Vernon Street to Whiting Avenue, Left on Whiting Avenue to East Street, Right on to East Street where the Parade will end.

This is the same Route the Parade has taken the past two years and the Committee and the Police Department were very happy with it. It causes the least number of problems in Dedham Square and eliminates most of the safety problems from previous years (EXCEPT CANDY THROWING)

Dear Members of the Board of Selectmen,

The Dedham Junior Women's Club Arts at Endicott summer concert series is beginning next month and, as in the past, our club would like permission to place signage promoting our concerts in Dedham.

We would like to ask if we might place approximately 12 18" x 24" lawn signs on town property throughout Dedham, including the landscaped area near the keystone lot in Dedham Square, landscaped area on High Street near Civic Pride clock, East Dedham Square near rock memorial and in the lane separating 'island' on High Street, the northwest corner of the Town Common, the rotary at East Street and Cedar Street, the island at Court Street and Washington Street, and at the rotary at Needham Street and Riverside Drive.

In addition, we would like to place a 2' x 6' vinyl banner on the railing of the Keystone lot, at High Street and Eastern Avenue.

They will be placed approximately two weeks before the concerts begin and be removed within one week of their ending. The concerts begin June 15, 2016 and they conclude July 27, 2016, unless there are rain dates, which are usually scheduled for Wednesdays in early to mid August.
