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Meeting called to order at 7:08

First order of Business

1) Leanne Jasset, calls for a reorganization of officers where the board rotates roles of chairpersons.

Jason Brogan is appointed Chairperson  
Dr. Stephen Camer, MD appointed Vice Chair  
Leanne Jasset is appointed Member

2) Catherine Cardinale, First order of Business:

- i. Hearing with Mr. Fleming owner and operator of McGolf Junior Golf Academy at McGolf. Asked to appear before the board for over 50 violations. Time spent by the Health Department on working with Mr. Fleming in order to make sure his camp was in compliance exceeded normal hours.
- ii. Mrs. Cardinale notifies the Board that Mr. Fleming knowingly went on to open his camp without a license, although he was aware of numerous violations, and operated for three days before the department was notified
- iii. Leanne Jasset asks Mr. Fleming for commentary ie: being non-compliant for two years straight.
- iv. Mr. Fleming states that he has run camps outside of Dedham, for 17 years. He states that he has a great appreciation for the work that the Jessica, Leontia, and

Catherine do., He states that he has never been put through such a rigorous inspection, and he didn't understand the scope of the regulations, and it was not his intention to be unprepared. He believes that he had completed the checklist, however after reading the regulations he now realizes it wasn't all there. He states that next year will not be a repeat of this year.

- v. The Board decides to allow the camp to run, as long as the regulations that are set forth are followed as well as, to review the binder from last year. Dr. Camer recommends a spot inspection and encourages that if Mr. Fleming has questions about the process, to please contact the department. Mr. Brogan speaks on behalf of himself and states that he is less inclined to be tolerant of the process not being followed next year and suggests the board put Mr. Fleming on the agenda for review at next meeting, as well as the camps past year's binder.

### 3) Catherine Cardinale's report

- i. 127 Curve Street the Property is making progress, however a gentleman who is the Nephew of the resident is stacking numerous items in the yard. State Representative Paul McMurty called Mrs. Cardinale to inquire about how to help this woman. Cardinale stated that she had intended to call this resident in front of the board. They came to an agreement whereas volunteers would come to the residence, and also a dumpster would be placed Mrs. Cardinale also spoke to the nephew that he had 24 hours to remove items.
- ii. Two new establishments, An Adult daycare and a new restaurants, El Centro. Still waiting for: Oscar's Chick Filet, Blue Ribbon BBQ, Horse Thieves, and Hooters.
