Dear Chairman Teehan,

I am writing on behalf of the Dedham Square Circle to request that a portion of Dedham Square be closed to vehicular traffic from 5-8:30 p.m. on the evening of Friday, December 1, 2017 for the Annual Dedham Square Holiday Stroll and Tree Lighting. This is the same request that has been approved by the Board of Selectmen for this event for the last several years.

Over 1,000 people from Dedham and surrounding communities are expected to come to the Square for the festivities on the night of the Stroll. It's a wonderful community-building event at which all the family-friendly entertainment and activities in the Square that night are free. The Stroll is a big night for the Square's merchants as well.

In order to ensure public safety and enjoyment, we are requesting that the following streets be closed during the event:

- High Street from the intersection at Washington Street down to the intersection at Harris Street.
- Eastern Avenue from the intersection at High Street up to the entrance of the Keystone Lot, across from CVS.

In addition, we are requesting that a portion of the Keystone Lot be closed to traffic and parked cars that evening. As the town's Christmas tree is in the corner of the parking lot closest to the Eastern Avenue and High Street intersection, we want to keep the surrounding area free of cars and request that the first three rows of parking spaces on this side of the lot be blocked off. Allowing pedestrians to walk freely in this closed off section of the lot and on the sections of street mentioned above will create a more inviting,

safer, and enjoyable community event. Again this year we will work with Chief D'Entremont and the Dedham Police Department to plan for police details in the Square that night.

I would also like to request that signage to promote the Stroll be erected one week before the event in the following public locations and taken down immediately following the event:

Sandwich Board Signs:

- Corner of Common St. and Bridge St.
- Corner of High St. and Harris St. in Dedham Square Crossing
- On the grass in front of Town Hall
- Corner of High St. and Eastern Avenue
- · Corner of High St. and Washington St.

Banner:

• To be hung on the fence atop the granite wall at the edge of the Keystone Lot.

Lastly, in order to ensure public safety and enjoyment of the Stroll we are asking for permission to keep any street vendors, representing companies not located in the Square, in a specific area during the event. I am referring to the vendors who sell novelty items such as balloons, plastic toys, noise makers, glow sticks, etc. In prior years we have had several of them pushing large heavy carts through a very crowded and condensed area filled with young children. These vendors also block visibility of the street entertainers, community groups and the tree lighting, and their sales tactics can often be aggressive. We are requesting that the street vendors be only allowed to have their carts in the following areas:

- Behind the crosswalk which extends across High Street from the Keystone Lot to Ron's Ice
 Cream, on the side of the crosswalk on which the Deli After Dark is located.
- Behind the crosswalk which extends across Eastern Avenue from the Keystone Lot to Big Bear Cafe, on the side of the crosswalk on which CVS is located.

As always, thank you for your consideration of our requests. We hope that you and members of the Board of Selectmen will join us for the festivities December 1st.

- Washington Street from Bryant Street to Harris Street


If you should approve our request, Dedham Square Circle will post decorative signage, as shown above, on every parking kiosk throughout the Square to inform the public of the free parking.

Hi Bill,

This is the most concerning location due to the product line that is sold. They generally draw a significant crowd which lines up.

People line up early at Best Buy (q#4). We have seen people there during the late afternoon on Thanksgiving. I would anticipate people on site prior to the 10 pm time estimated on the questionnaire. They need to be ready to manage early line formation. The portable light that was ordered needs to cover the north west (rear rt. 1 side) corner of the building and the rear of the building (q#5). The line can get to the rear of the building. I don't think 150 feet of steel barriers is enough (q#7). I recommend about double this length to include halfway along the side of the building. The number of people allowed into the building at once when the store opens should be a small manageable amount, 25-50 with a couple minutes in between each group (q#9) to ensure an orderly entry within the building capacity. They need security people to monitor the line outside asap. Store personnel outside managing the line/handing out tickets for high demand items should be wearing some type of clothing to identify themselves as store employees (q#8). The earlier security personnel are on scene, the better. We need to know what the detail officer request will be specifically (q#16). We will try to fill early. If we are unable to fill, we will notify Best Buy so that they can have a contingency plan. Merchandise pick-up should be outlined. We had some concerns in the past with merchandise being picked up at the front door with vehicles pulling up and a large amount of pedestrians in the area. They should have a porta-potty on site (q#10). People will be in line for an extended period of time. They also should have a clean up plan for the early am. Trash is often left behind by people in the line.

1. What date and hours are being requested to open a retail business in Accordance with Town of Dedham by law, Chapter 13, Section 42A?

We request to open from 1:00 a.m. on Friday, Nov. 24, 2017 and continuing through normal business hours with close at 11:00 p.m.

2. Will the store close prior to opening under the permitted hours?

Yes, the store will close per normal business hours on Wednesday, November 22. 2017.

3. How will permitted hours be advertised?

> Store hours will be advertised online, in print, in store, and through TV advertising.

4. Are customers anticipated to arrive early and wait outside prior to permitted opening? If so, how many customers are anticipated to arrive prior to opening? At what anticipated time are customers beginning to arrive?

Customers are anticipated to begin arriving approximately one (1) hour prior to opening, i.e. around Midnight. Approximately 500 customers are anticipated.

5. How will the outside area be illuminated during permitted hours and anticipated time-frame of when customers may arrive and wait prior to permitted opening?

All exterior parking lot lights as well as exterior building lights will be on at least one (1) hour prior to opening. Customers will be queued in a line outside the building prior to store opening. Police detail will be requested from one (1) hour prior to store opening until four (4) hours after store opening.

6. How and where will a line of customers form prior to permitted opening?

The line will form at the entrance and run the length of the building along the sidewalk. The store manager has been trained with respect to crowd control and safety measures.

7. Will crowd control barriers be used? If so, where will they be located?

Yes, crowd control barriers will be utilized and will be set up outside the entrance.

8. How will store personnel manage customers arriving prior to opening under permitted hours?

Starting at Midnight, store management along with hourly team members will be specifically scheduled to work line control to ensure that customers are safe and in control. Police detail will be utilized for one (1) hour prior to store opening and four (4) hours after store opening. Communication tools are provided to hourly and management team members to ensure guest communication is maximized.

9. How will customers wait prior to permitted opening be allowed into the store?

Customers will be queued into the store in groups of 50 until the building reaches maximum capacity as established by the fire department and which is clearly posted in the entrance vestibule. Upon maximum capacity, customers will be permitted to enter as an equivalent number of customers exit the building to ensure a safe environment for all customers.

10. Will restroom facilities be available for customers arriving prior to opening under permitted hours?

Restroom facilities will be available on an emergency basis for those customers arriving one (1) hour prior to store opening.

11. Are there special promotions being offered in association with permitted opening?

Yes, there are special promotions being offered through the Toys "R" Us weekly circular.

12. Are there any advertised items in limited quantities?

No, there are no items with limited quantities anticipated. However, customer demand may exceed projected sales.

13. Are any high demand items advertised?

Yes, there are several high demand items identified.

HI Bill,

This is the exact same application as last year. Therefore, I offer the same comments below. We did not have any issues with Toy R Us last year. I think the only location with an issue was Sears who had a shoplifter. I'll confirm with the Mall about parking lot lights and find out what security they plan on having on hand. Also below is an e-mail thread related to steel barriers which would be much preferred and the ability to fill a police detail:

This looks to be okay. I do not believe there has been a large early arriving crowd at this location in recent years. I am inquiring with the Dedham Mall to see what their plan is for overnight security and lighting. I would suggest some type of security presence/eyes on the exterior of the store more than one hour prior to the planned opening. Starting at 10 pm might be good. Steel barriers should be used to form lines outside of the entrance. Enough should be in place to gather the anticipated line. We would like a contact number for the manager on duty during this opening please.

E-mail thread from last year:

Hi Bill,

Just a little info to be shared with the BOS in reviewing this request:

- 1. I can't guarantee that we will be able to fill the police detail request. We will try, but probably won't know for sure until within 24 hours or so of the scheduled hours. There is no requirement for officers to work private details. In recent years, it has been more challenging to fill these Black Friday details. I know the law indicates "there can be no work on the premise" prior to 12 am on Friday. I am not certain that this applies to security monitoring the exterior of the building if the decision is made to hire a private security company. Toys R Us will probably have some people showing up earlier than 11 pm. Recently there has not been many showing up early at this location. Last communication I had with Mall Mgmt was that they had not finalized what security staff they would have on hand or when.
- 2. I looked on line and called one company and was told they still have some steel barriers available for Black Friday: http://www.rentnational.com/in-dedham ma-rental service areas.aspx. In the past Toys R Us has used the same type of barrier as you see at movie theaters. Steel barriers are what I would recommend to do this correctly. Again, we have not seen a large crowd queueing at this location in recent years.

Thank you for your response. To follow up on your questions:

- 1. Regarding security in advance of opening, I understand that the store has requested police detail from 11pm to 7am. We will also have Toys "R" Us representatives at the store to assist with crowd management and other issues starting at Midnight (which is the earliest they can be there under Massachusetts law).
- 2. We have looked into and been unable to obtain steel crowd control barriers, but the store will use the standard barriers, which were used last year without incident.
- 3. The contact for this year will continue to be District Manager Edward King. His mobile phone number is 201-694-4187.

Please let us know if you have other questions, and thank you for your courtesies.
